EBP Sports Men's Bowling Club Club Championship Rules of Play

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. The controlling body for all Club events is the Match Committee
- 2. All decisions made by the Match Committee regarding Club competitions shall be final
- 3. The Match Committee shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to events on the scheduled date
- All events are to be played according to the rules and conditions of Bowls Australia and Bowls NSW except as decided by the Match Committee
- 5. For all Singles events, it is a condition of entry that you make yourself available to be a marker. if you are nominated to mark and are unable to do so it is your responsibility to find a replacement. If you are not prepared to mark please do not enter the event.
- 6. Full Club uniform must be worn for all events

PLAY OR FORFEIT RULE

All events will be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on the scheduled date. However, where circumstances prevent this, a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must obtain permission from the Match Committee. If under any circumstances a game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Match Committee.
